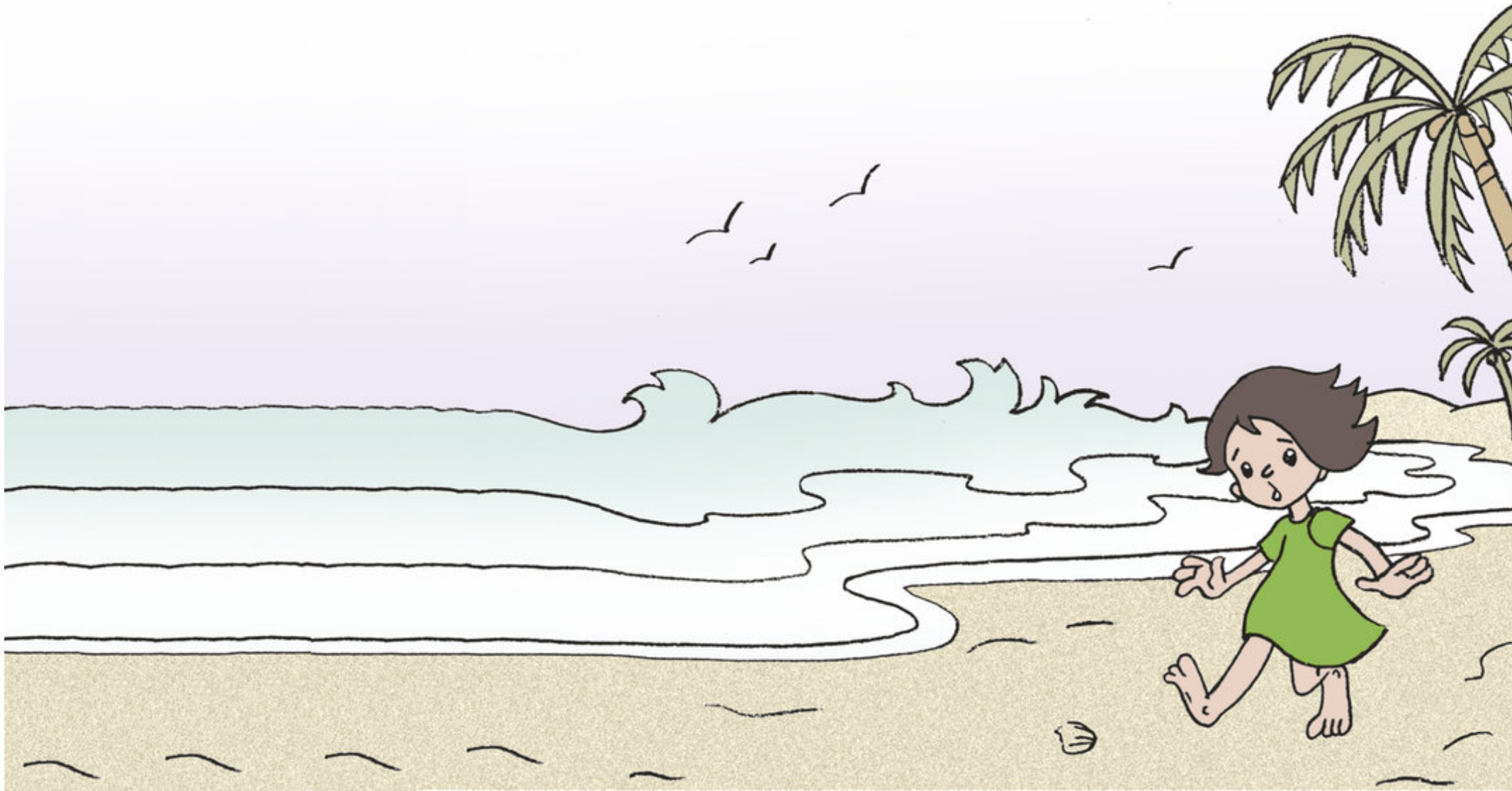

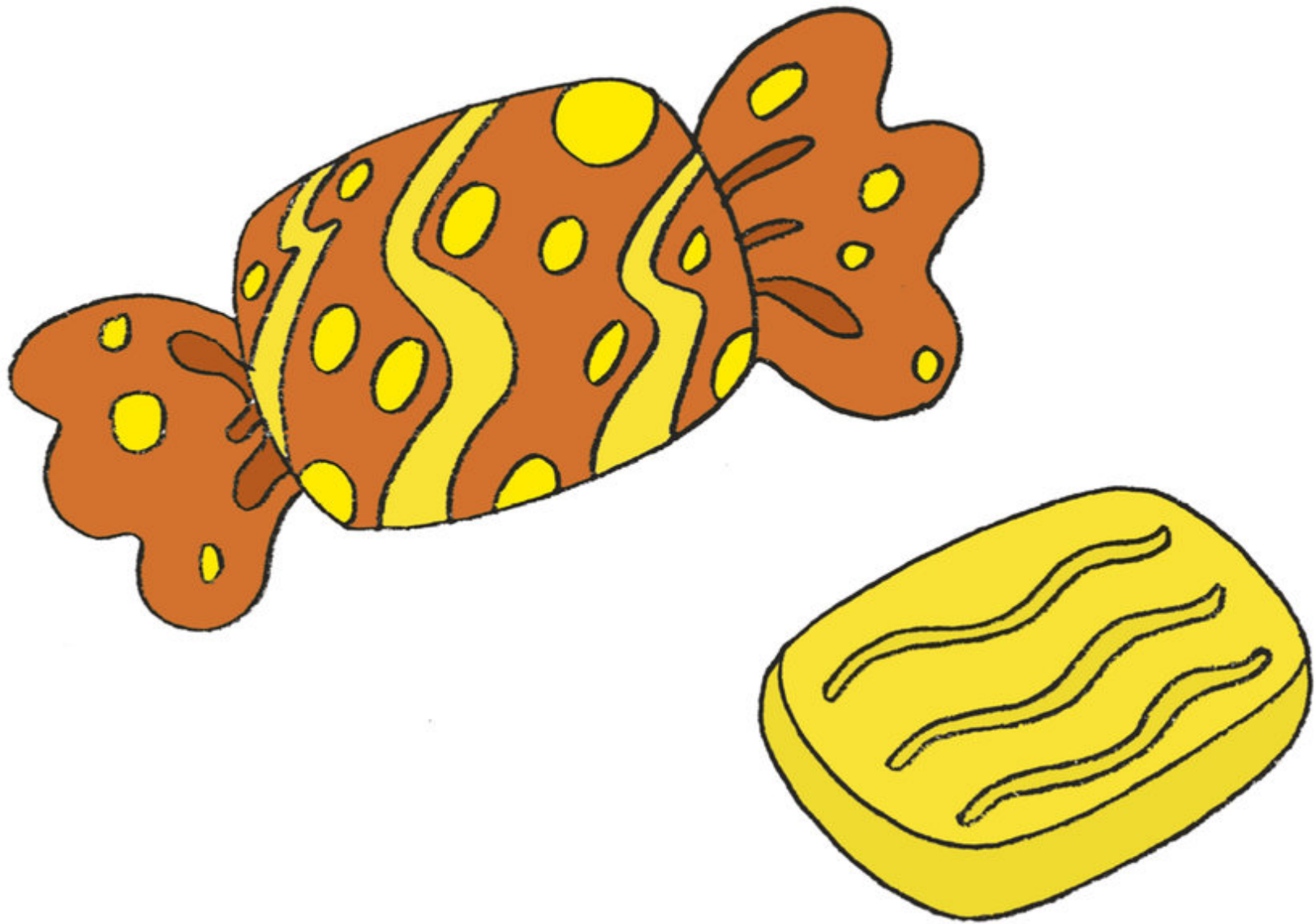

Pourquoi le citron est-il sûr ?



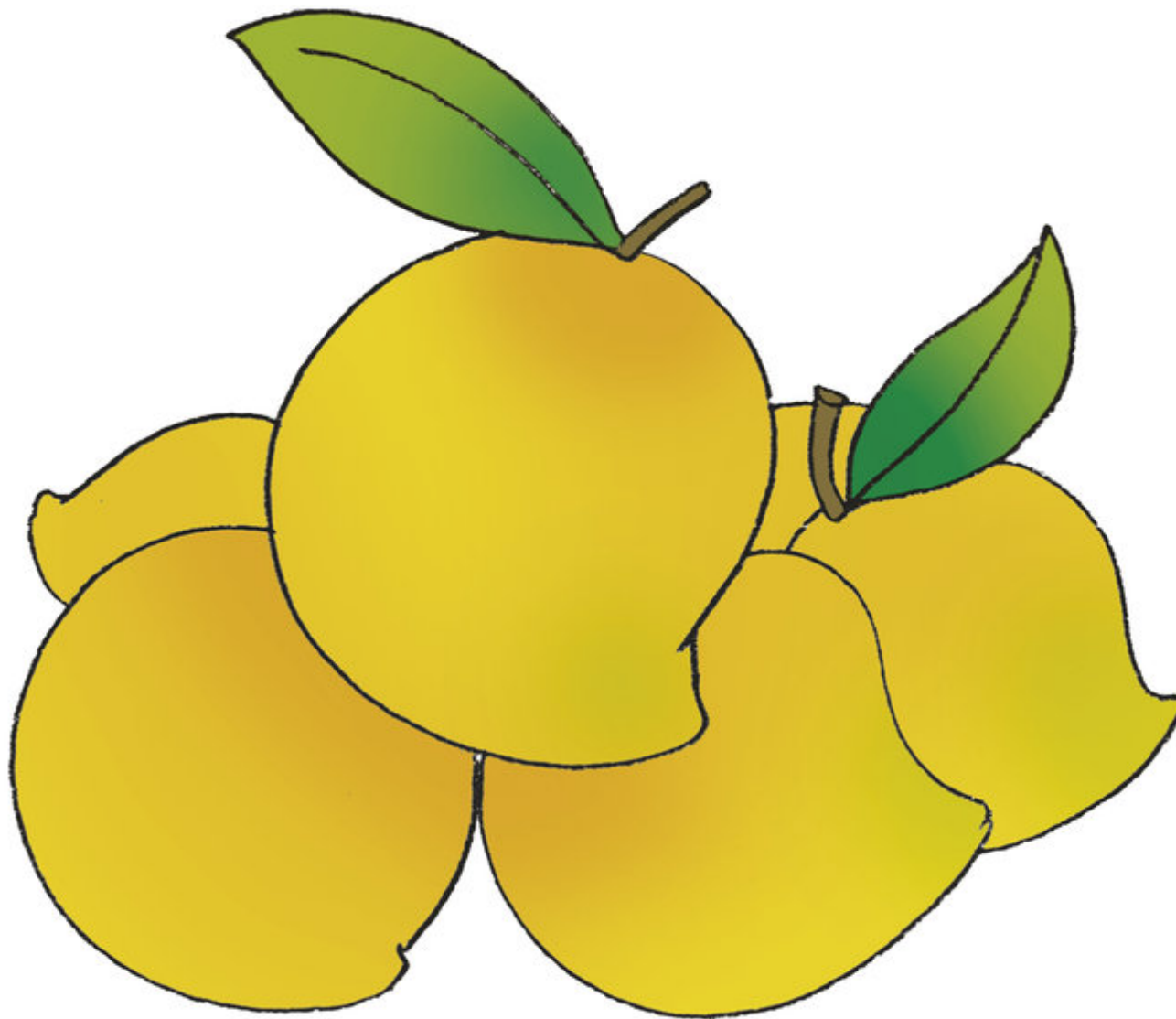

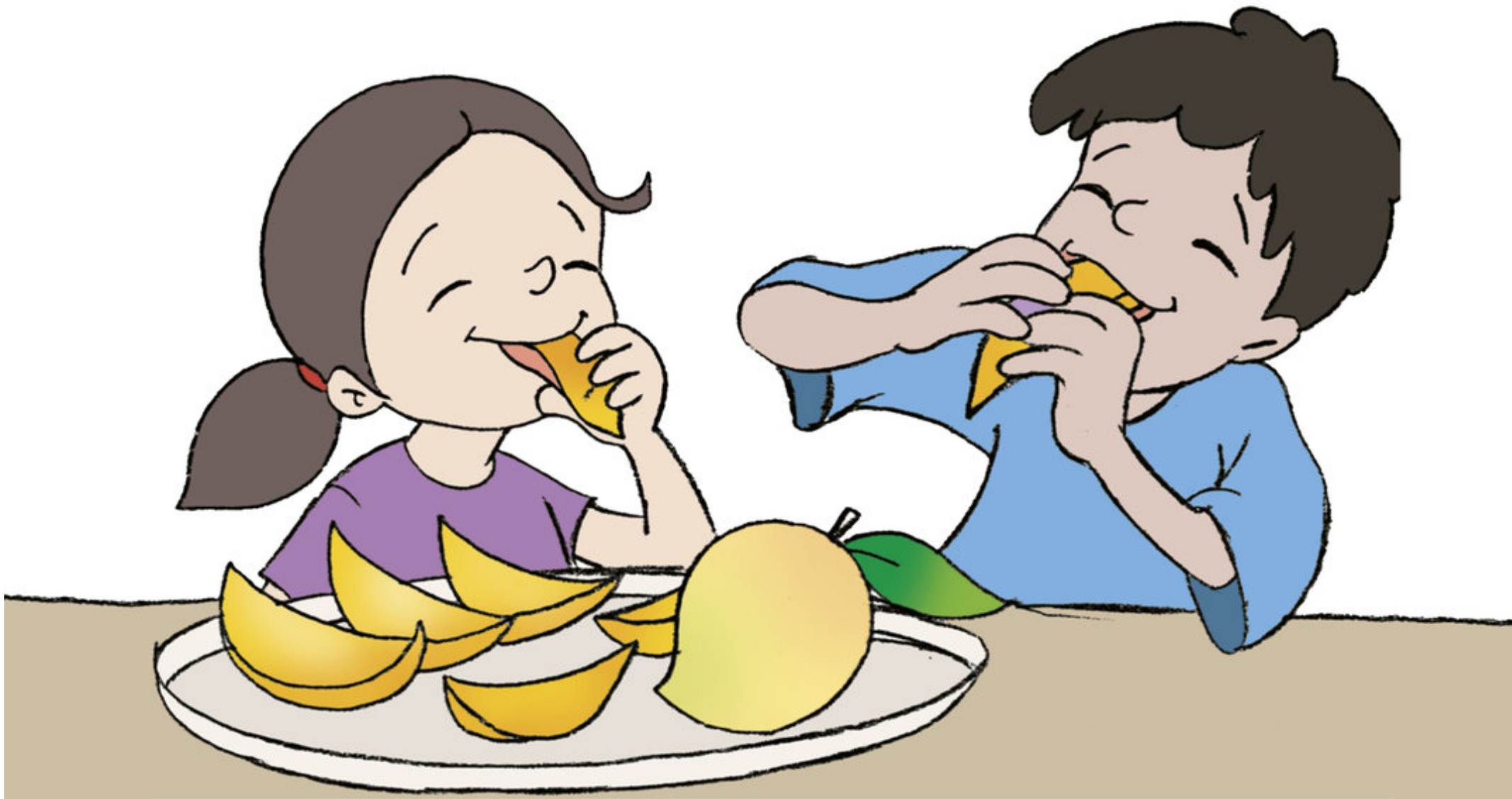
Est-ce qu'il y a du sel dans les larmes ?
