






Ils quittent leur maison située au milieu des champs et commencent leur voyage.

- Tiens, vous avez quitté votre maison, répond Miss Rafale de vent. Vous savez que ce voyage va vous transformer?




 Cela veut dire que nous allons devenir des tasses, des vases, des cruches ou des pots, n'est-ce pas, Miss Rafale de vent ?




- Oui, mais n'oubliez pas que vous allez devoir faire face à certains défis pendant ce voyage.




Ils prirent des bains de soleil et se reposèrent dans le vent.


