

Pas question de rentrer dormir chez moi cette nuit, se dit Léo. Je vais rester ici et attendre l'autocar.




Le lendemain matin, il y a une longue file d'attente à l'arrêt de l'autocar.


Léo essaie de se faufiler entre les voyageurs.
