## En savoir plus sur les becs



Les **piverts** possèdent un bec solide et pointu qui leur permet de percer des trous dans les arbres pour y faire leur nid ou pour trouver des insectes à manger.

Les **martins-pêcheurs** possèdent un long bec pointu qui ne rive pas la surface de l'eau quand ils plongent pour attraper des poissons.



Les **toucans** possèdent un magnifique bec multicolore qui leur permet de se camoufler parmi les fleurs.

Les **moineaux** possèdent un bec en forme de cône, court et pointu, qui leur permet de broyer des graines.





Les **spatules** utilisent leur long bec plat et arrondi pour fouiller la vase à la recherche de petits poissons, d'amphibiens et de crabes.

Le bec recourbé des **flamants roses** leur permet de filtrer du plancton, des petits poissons et des larves d'insectes dans les eaux peu profondes et boueuses.



Les **perroquets** utilisent leur bec en forme de pinces pour ouvrir les noix.

Les **calaos** possèdent un casque sur le bec qui leur permet d'amplifier les cris qu'ils émettent et de mieux les propager.





Les **souïmangas** possèdent un long bec recourbé qui leur permet d'aspirer le nectar et d'attraper des araignées ou des insectes au fond des fleurs.

Les **colibris** possèdent un très long bec fin qu'ils plongent au fond des fleurs pour aspirer le nectar.



Les **pélicans** pêchent les poissons avec leur bec en forme de poche. Ils recrachent l'eau puis engloutissent les poissons.



Les **macareux** sont capables d'attraper et de transporter beaucoup de poissons à la fois dans leur bec.
