







Gulli partit en courant et revint bientôt avec sa petite boîte marron.




## Bing! Paf! Pouf!

Voyons ce que Gulli a trouvé, cette fois!




Un entonnoir muni d'une très large ouverture. On verse n'importe quoi dedans et ça s'écoule parfaitement, goutte après goutte.

— Merci beaucoup pour ton aide, Gulli, dit Oncle Mangal.




- Que cherches-tu, Mamie? demanda Gulli à sa grand-mère.
