

Kamal avait un chien dans sa maison.


Il s'appelait Bhaunku.

Il a volé jusqu'à un grand arbre dans la cour. Il s'est assis au sommet.




Il y avait un paon assis sur le même arbre.

Bhaunku a fait du bruit d'en bas, « Wouaf! Wouaf!»




Le corbeau a eu peur.
