« Devines-tu de quoi il s'agit ? » demande-t-elle.


« C'est un cercle. » Jeenu fait la grimace. Elle n'aime pas ce jeu stupide.

Jeenu réfléchit, puis elle sourit.


« C'est un visage qui sourit ! » dit-elle.

*Activité : Que peux-tu dessiner avec trois cercles ?*




Ajji dessine une autre forme.

« Bien joué, Jeenu ! » dit Ajji. « Regarde qui est venu jouer avec nous ! »


*Activité : Que peux-tu dessiner avec trois cercles et quatre triangles ?*


Ajji dessine une forme avec quatre côtés.

« C'est un carré ! Hummm ... regarde Ajji, j'ai dessiné une fenêtre. »






« Veux-tu un arbre près de ta fenêtre ? » demande Ajji.

« Oui Ajji, merci ! » dit Jeenu.


Elle regarde tous les dessins à la craie. Peut-elle les peindre maintenant ?


