« Je pourrais mélanger. »





« Tu es encore un peu **petit** », a dit Maman.

« La **marmite** pourrait tomber. Mais tu peux m'aider en allant **chercher** des aliments. »


« Peux-tu m'apporter un **oignon**, s'il te plait. »

« Cela **sentira** bon une fois **cuit.** »




« Maintenant, j'ai besoin de **tomates**. Non, ceci est une **pomme**.

Les tomates sont également rondes et rouges mais tu vas les trouver dans le réfrigérateur. »


« Peux-tu m'apporter des **pommes de terre**.

« Le **dîner** est-il prêt ? »




« Si tu as faim, tu peux manger une **pomme** en attendant. »

« C'est une surprise. Attends et regarde. »


« Et qu'est-ce c'est que **cela** ? »

C'est **vert** également. »






« Apporte du pain s'il te plait.

Non, il ne va pas dans la marmite mais sur la table. »





Maman amène la **marmite** sur la table et commence à servir.
