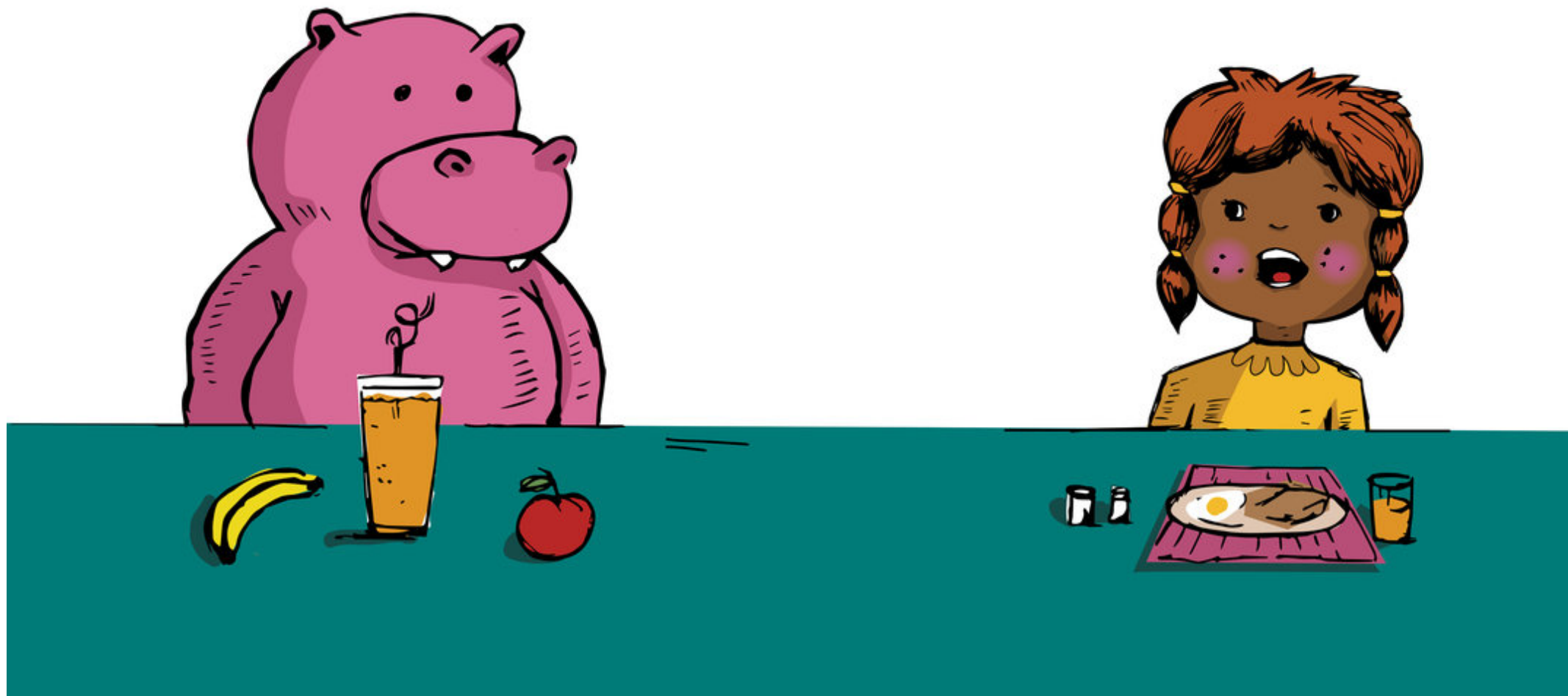

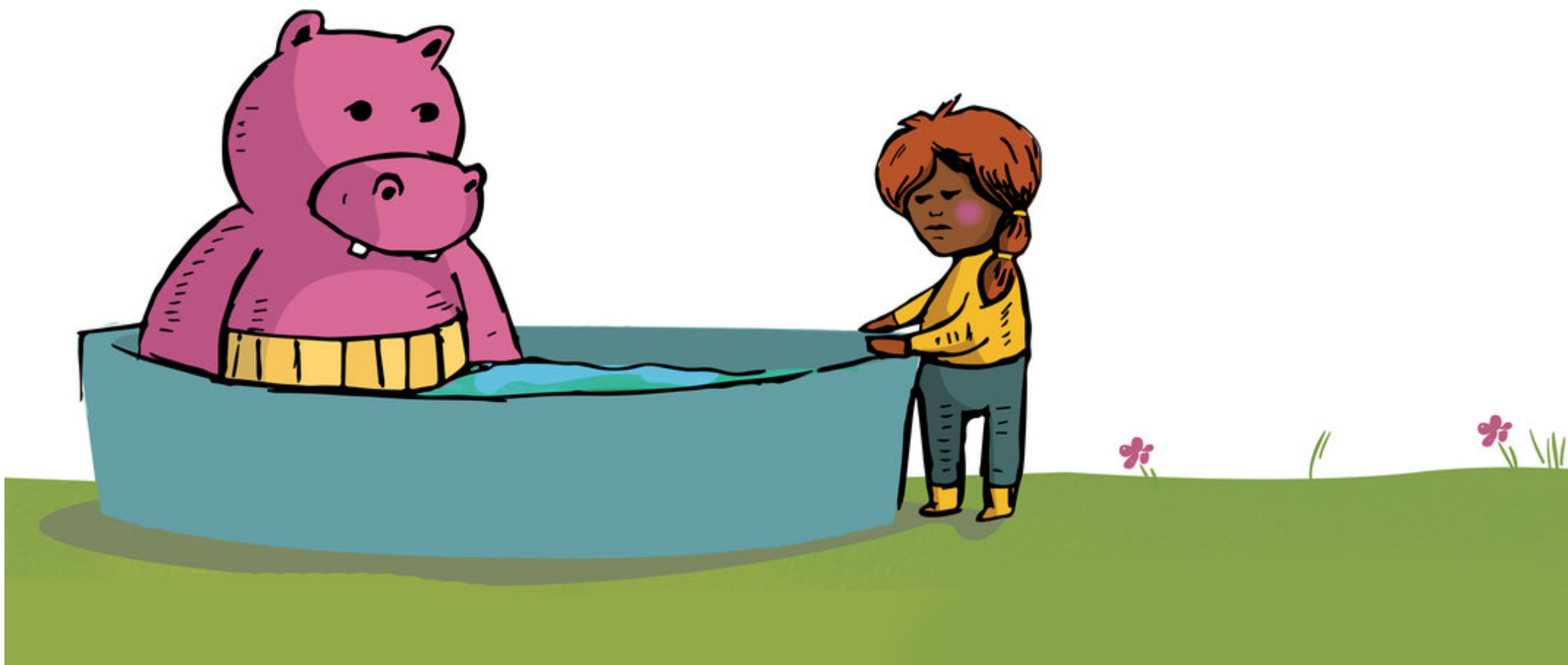

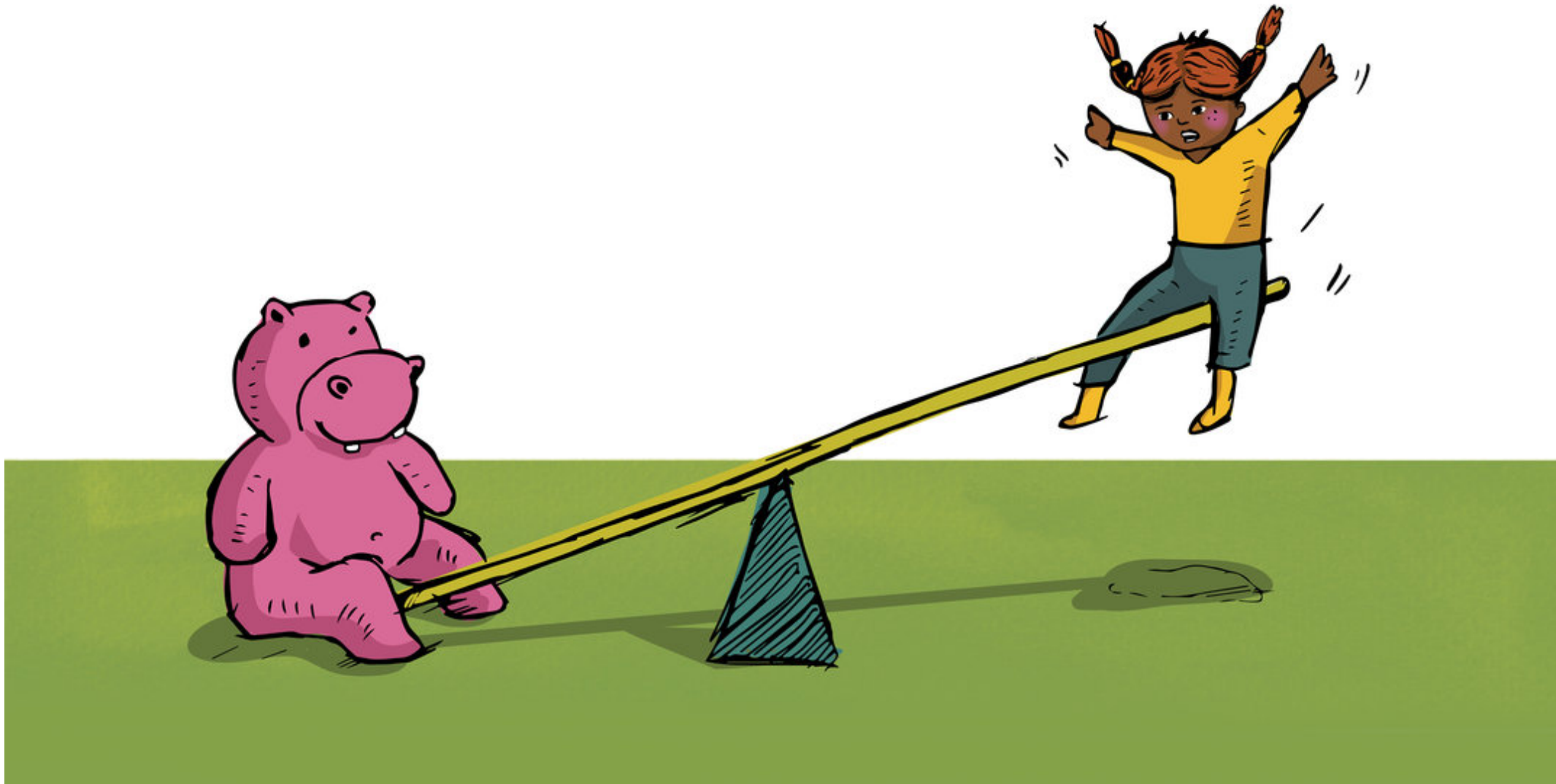


Lucy chercha partout dans le jardin.

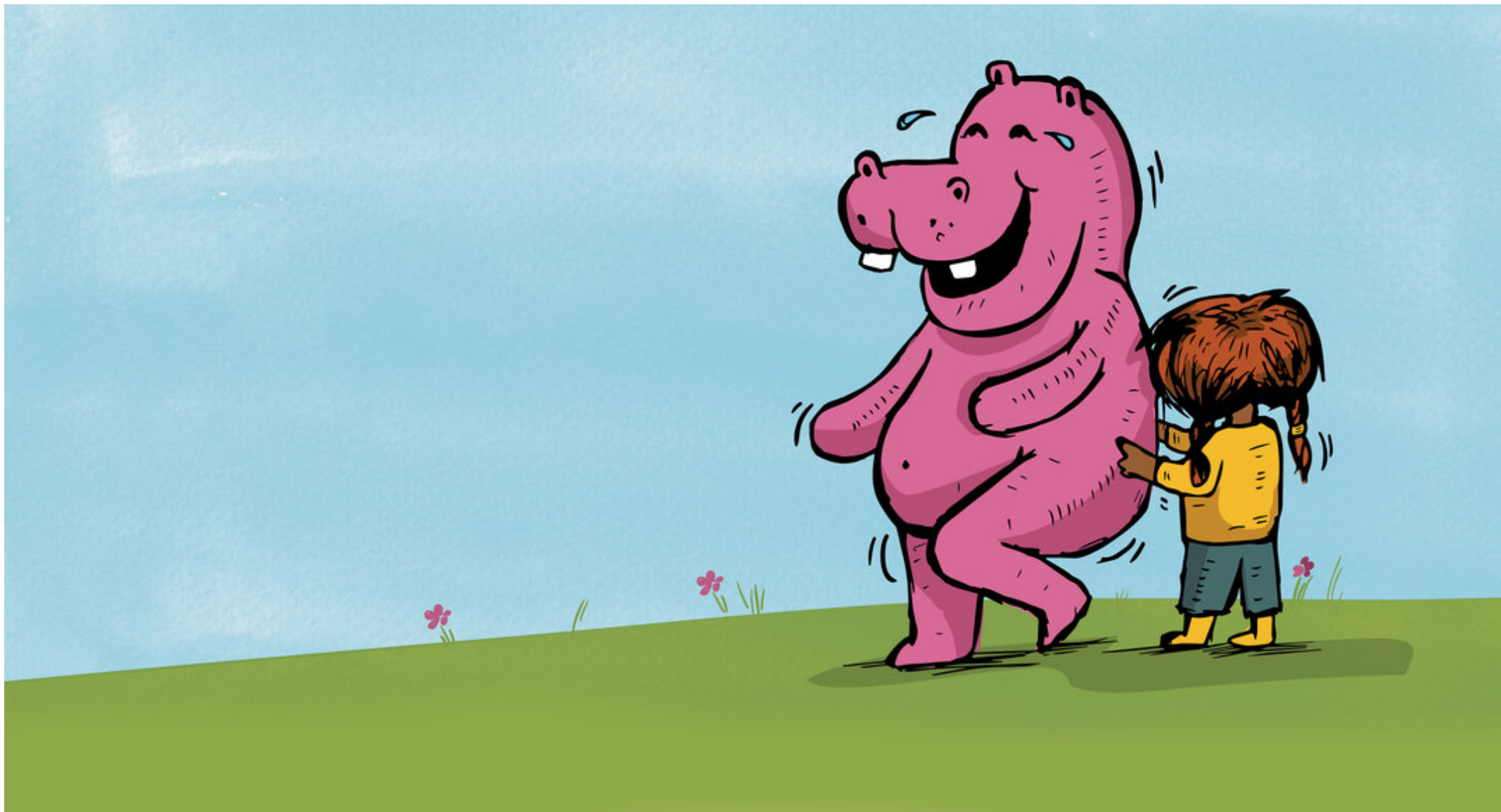
— Où est Thabi ? demanda-t-elle au voisin.

— Elle joue dans le parc, répondit-il.





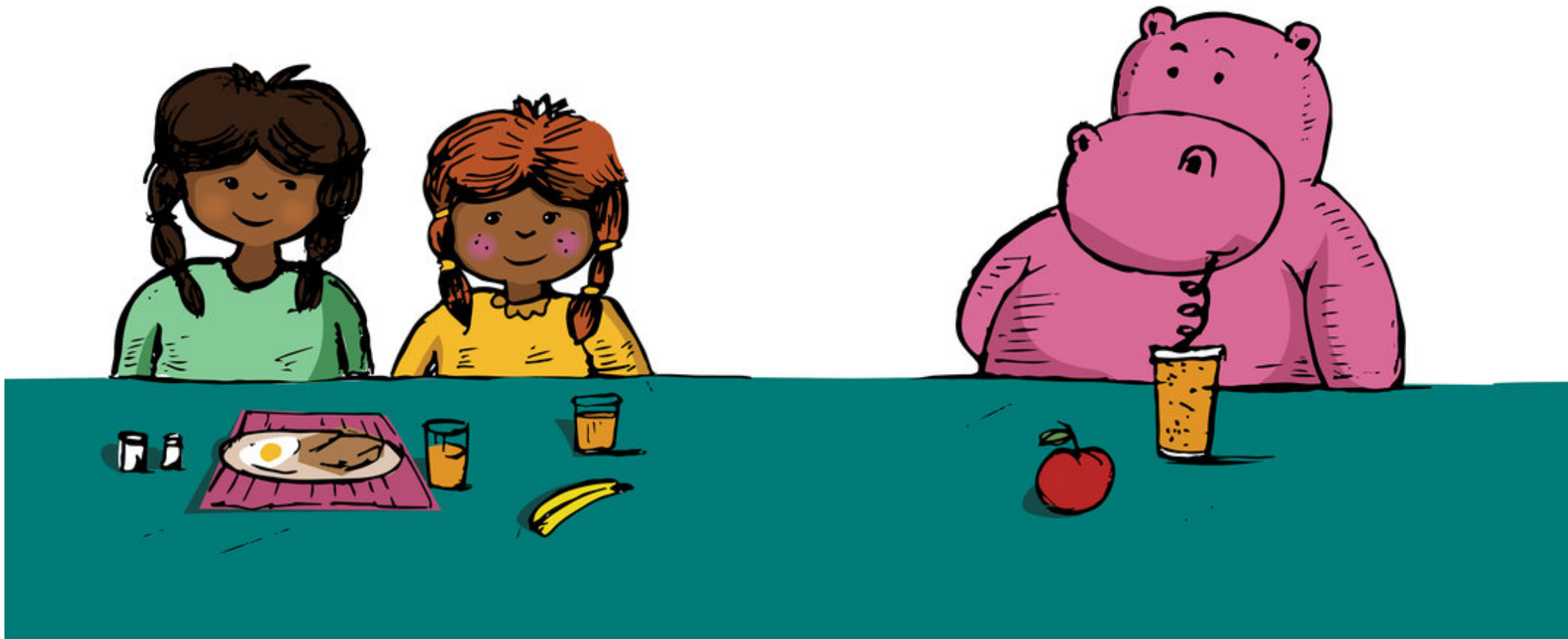

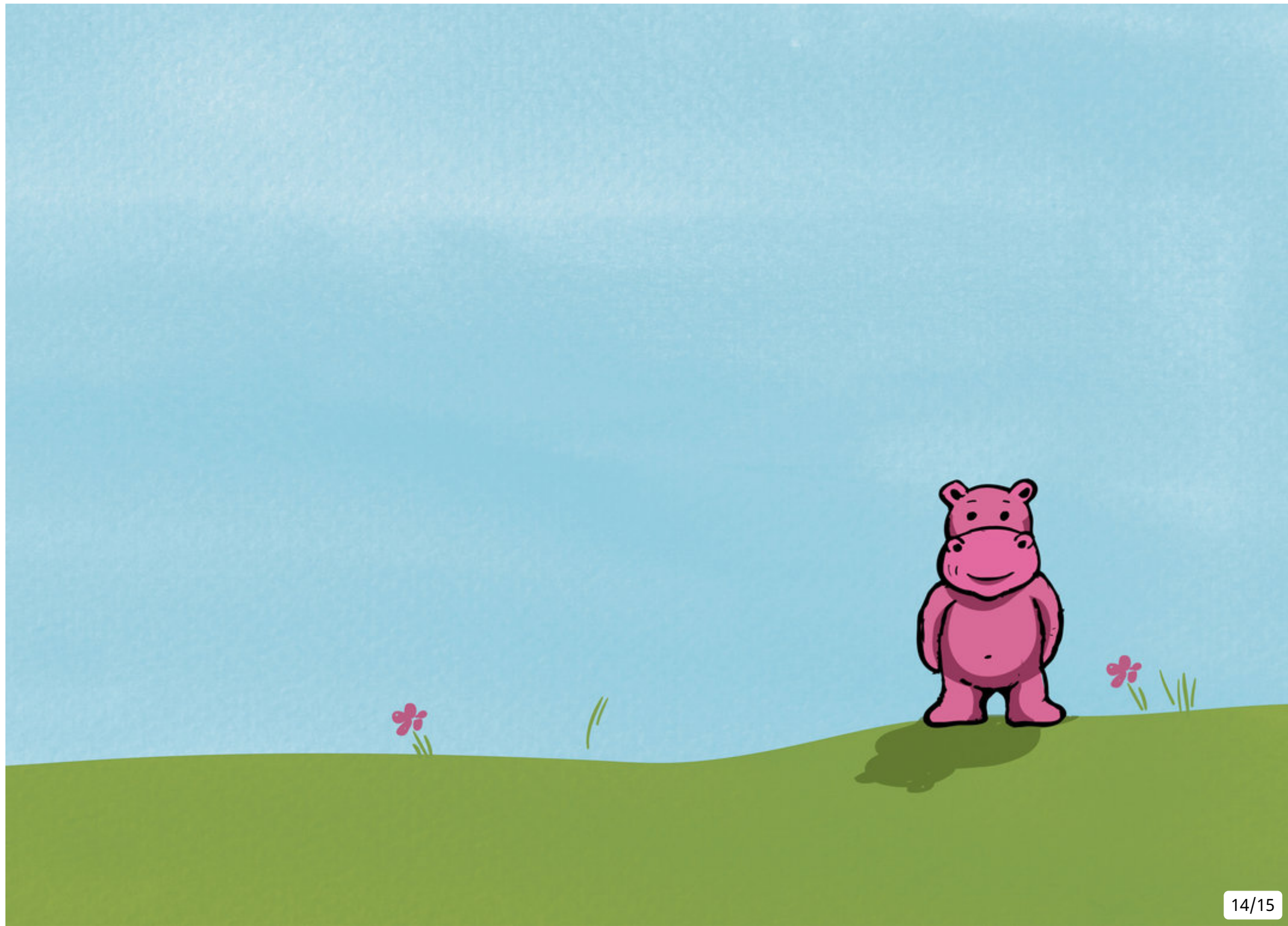
Lucy entendit alors un drôle de bruit.
