



Un jour j'ai rencontré Agnès. Agnès est maitresse.




Agnès utilise des béquilles pour marcher.

Metobo est albinos. Il a des problèmes avec ses yeux et sa peau.




Ma voisine est Moraa. Elle est agricultrice.
