Miaou, le chat, va et vient dans la pièce tandis que Lida dessine.

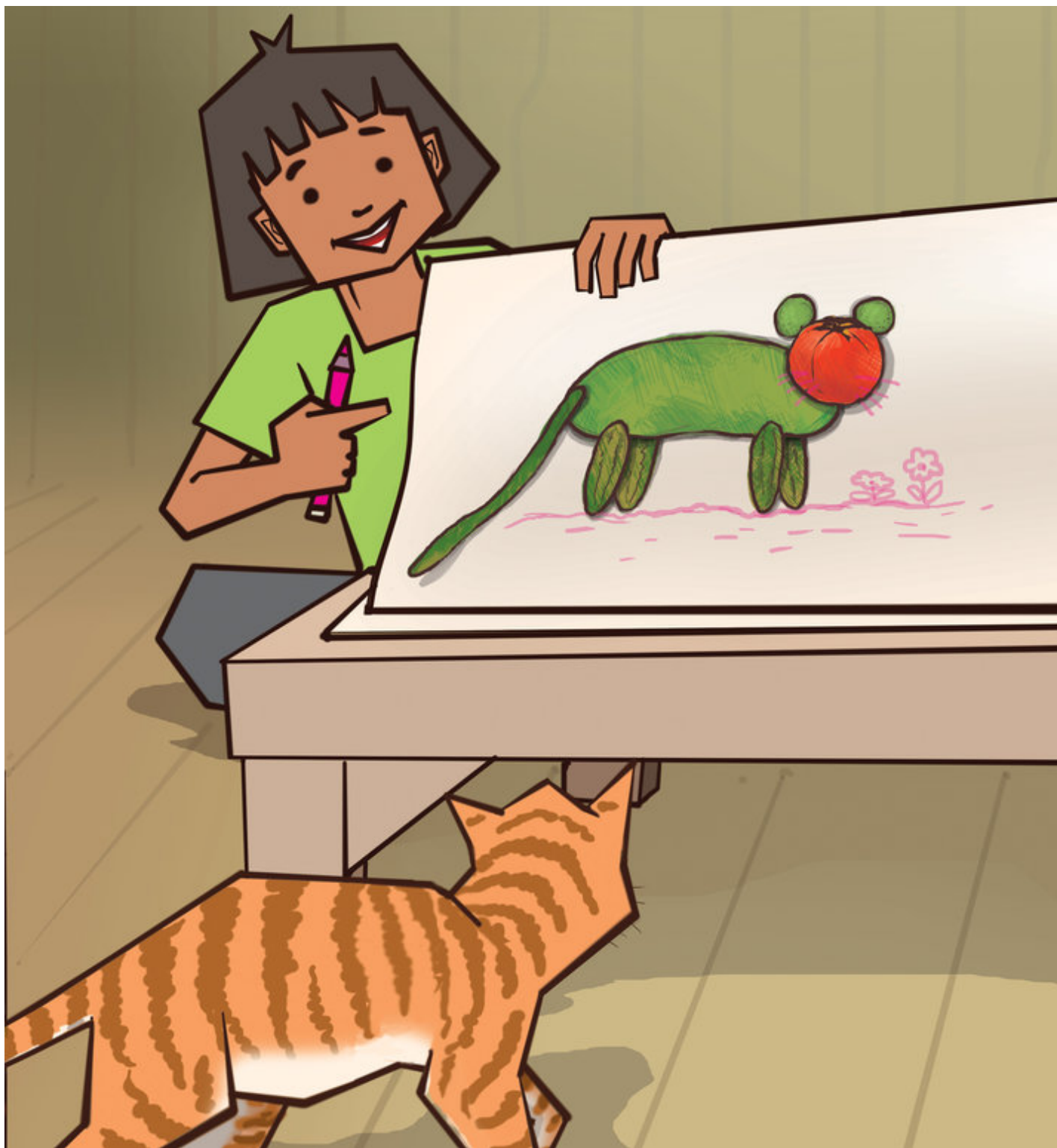

« Et voilà mon dessin de Miaou, le chat ! » s'écrie Lida.

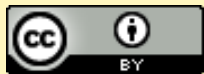
