



À la vue de ce petit robot triste, Lily, l'une des petites filles, s'approcha.






- Bonjour, je m'appelle Lily, dit-elle.

Un jour, Roobo parla à Lily de son nouveau projet : ils allaient construire un train ensemble. Il lui montra une photo.




Mais comment faire ? « Réfléchissons ! » suggéra Lily. Et ils se mirent à réfléchir.



Roobo était doté de nombreux pouvoirs électroniques.


Il les utilisa pour créer des boîtes vertes.
